

Dear Ivy Hawn Parents,


Due to ongoing safety and security concerns from multiple stakeholders, Ivy Hawn is revising its current parent drop-off, pick-up, and parking procedures beginning April 1, 2019. This new traffic pattern will enable us to more closely align to the district's expectations for public school safety and security. **The following procedures will be in effect starting Monday morning:**

- Due to the addition of a new passing lane, staff members parking has been reassigned parking to the top lot.
- To accommodate parent parking, 40 new parking spots will be available in front of the new addition on Ohio St. in addition to 9 spots at the former Jeep garage on Ohio and Pleasant.
- Our new traffic pattern in the parent loop will no longer be conducted using double lanes. Drop-off and pick-up will be curbside only. Students will no longer be able to exit their vehicles on the left.
- Grade level zones have been revised in order to accommodate Ivy Hawn families and single riders
- If you have been assigned a Green Zone (Zones 0-3), you will drop off and pick up between the elementary gym and the flagpole. (Area will be marked in green)
- If you have been assigned a Pink Zone (Zones 4-8), you will use the outer passing lane and drop off between the flagpole and volleyball gym. (Area will be marked in pink)

- A new Parent Waiting area will be located by the elementary gym and clearly marked with signage. This will alleviate traffic congestion in the elementary lobby and allow us to get our students safely out of the building in the afternoon. Staff members will be assigned to this area to assist you with escorting your students off campus.
- All students will receive a zone regardless of After Care, Bus, or any other after school activity in order to accommodate future need.
- The only crosswalks available to use are located by the elementary gym and in front of the flagpole.
- Fencing on Lakeview Dr. and barriers have been put in place to provide additional safety coverage for walkers.

Thank you in advance for your continued support and understanding with these new traffic procedures. Ensuring the safety of our students, employees, and parent volunteers is our top priority and will enable us to provide the safest school environment for all.
