

<b>Term</b>	Definition
<b>Primary Source</b>	A source FROM the time period you're studying. Also can indicate PROXIMITY (closeness) to an event (like a first hand account.)
<b>Secondary Source</b>	A source written AFTER the time period you're studying. Also indicates DISTANCE from the event (she told me that he saw)
<b>Reliability</b>	Whether a source's opinion is trustworthy and qualified.
<b>Objective</b>	"just the facts." Tries to have no opinion
<b>Subjective</b>	opinion
