Season & Delivery Dates

Timing

- The timing of the Fashion Industry revolves around "**Markets – Trade**" events held throughout the year at Apparel Marts in major cities around the world.
- **Sales Rep** show one or more lines of clothing, on behalf of garments manufacturers, from booths that they temporarily hire or from showrooms that they permanently occupy.
- **Buyers** attend these events and place orders.
- These trade events are not open to the general public and garments are sold in **bulk**, at **wholesale** prices.
- These Markets occurs at specific times of the year, and in advance of the season for which the garments have been designed.

Major Seasons

SPRING

- Designed: August
- Sold: October
- Delivered: January

FALL

(Known as Fall 2, if the Early Fall/transition Season was acknowledged)

- Design: March
- Sold: June
- Delivered: August



Minor Seasons

SUMMER

Designed: November

Sold: January

Deliver: March

Designed: February

Sold: April

Designed: June

Sold: September
